- We do ask for a £180 contribution towards board and lodging for the training course and you will need to pay for your own travel to the course. In the cases of financial hardship a full or part subsidy may be available—please email james@ate.org.uk if this applies to you.
- You must send details of a teacher / tutor / or similar who has known you well for 2 years, and we will contact them to confirm A) that you are suitable to work closely with children in a residential setting, and B) that he/she knows of nothing at all which might make you a risk to children.
- ATE reserves the right to not allow trainees to work on Superweeks if, after the course, we feel they are not suitable for the work involved.
